2023 Ministry Support Grant

The Common Life Ministry of Palo Duro Presbytery is constantly reviewing guidelines for the administration of Ministry Support Grants. Currently, these guidelines are as follows.

- 1. The grant application is to be approved by the Session of the congregation before its submission to the committee.
- 2. Commitments for these grants are made on an annual basis (with application in November for the year following). Decisions will be made this year.
- 3. All churches have the Christian responsibility of exercising good stewardship, which means making its members aware of the financial needs of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and providing a means for its members to respond financially to these needs. Therefore, it is required that every church receiving a Ministry Support Grant prepare an annual budget based on needs rather than on the anticipated grant and that the information will be shared with the congregation.
- 4. Each church that receives a Ministry Support Grant is encouraged to seek long-term solutions and budgeting programs independent from the Ministry Support Grant and to share its long-range financial needs and program goals with the Presbytery's Common Life Ministry.
- 5. Applications should be typed, if possible. A fillable PDF application is on the presbytery's website (www.paloduropresbytery.org/resources) linked to the Resource page.

The attached Ministry Grant Application must be completed in its entirety and **returned by December 4, 2023**, to Palo Duro Presbytery, P.O. Box 16267, Lubbock, TX 79490 or emailed to <u>asstadmin@paloduropresbytery.org</u>. No action will be taken on incomplete applications. The grants for 2024 will be awarded at the Presbytery's Common Life Ministry meeting on a date yet to be announced.
